
From Q2 2022, there will be an Airport Flyer route to Dublin Airport that will have a pickup point at the hotel entrance, utilising 100% electric vehicles.






Nestled in this cultural and historic quarter of the city, renowned for eateries and bars, our venue is inspired by the history of its location.

It features design elements that pay homage to the archaeological discoveries found on the site dating to Dublin's earliest Viking settlement.



A world-class event space, ideal for international and domestic business conferences, as well as exhibitions for up to 1,100 delegates.




The largest event space The Douglas Hyde suite: an 800-seater divisible and double-height conference room. Located on the lower ground floor, the suite spans over 704 sq. m, has a ceiling height of 7.7 m and state-of-the-art AV.

There are also five spacious suites on the upper ground floor, The Higgins Suite, The Robinson Suite and The Phoenix Suite, which allow for extra event space or flexibility. These can be used for breakout rooms, workshops, team building, exhibitions, or office space and offer natural daylight.




Dublin Royal Convention Centre Capacity Chart


As well as high-speed Wi-Fi, our meeting spaces offers the latest presentation technologies with large format full HD projection systems.



Goldsmith Hall

The multifunctional Goldsmith Hall conference space can cater for 400 people theatre-style and 270 for a gala banquet. This versatile space can host many event options with partition walls that can divide it into three sections, with a large pre-function area for exhibition space and networking. As well as offering natural daylight, the Goldsmith Hall has in-built AV.

Meeting Spaces

The dedicated 1st floor meeting space can cater for boardroom meetings of 10 to 80 delegates theatre-style. The 7 meeting rooms here are perfect for smaller meetings, breakout rooms for workshops or for exhibition space. All meeting rooms have in-built plasma screens, or screen and projector, natural daylight, and air conditioning.

Sky Suite




Dyflin Garden Terrace




A historical civic square built to inspire you

Le Pole Square respects the past and embraces the future.

A landscaped civic square with the excavated remains of St. Michael Le Pole Church, is the focal point of the scheme.
Once St. Michael of the Pool, due to the round tower overlooking the 'Black Pool' or Dubh Linn in Irish, from which Dublin takes its name. The great storm of 1775 did irreparable damage to the tower eventually leading to the church being pulled down.

Inspired by its history, this LEED Gold building keeps the name Le Pole alive encouraging visitors to reflect on this medieval legacy. Multifunctional in nature, this public space offers an immersive cultural experience. The garden is landscaped with tiles replicating designs taken from the church interior. This space gives visitors a social meeting place with a spa, café and gallery.
